Leah Gangelhoff Coaching Workshop May 25-26, 2024 Manchester University, North Manchester, IN

2 Nose You Is 2 Loves You is excited to welcome Leah Gangelhoff back to Indiana for a coaching weekend! This will be an excellent chance to be coached by Leah in a trial setting (in fact, it will be at the location of our May 2023 trial - Manchester University). The format will be smaller groups (only 6 to a group), so working teams will have plenty of opportunity to get individual attention and several searches in a wide variety of scenarios.

To make this weekend as cost effective as possible, participants will be responsible for their own lunches. You should be able to order a box lunch from the campus catering - that information will be in the Final Details email. Auditing will be permitted, and very welcome, with the understanding that working teams have priority with questions and we will expect auditors to respect this. Leah will send out a Questionnaire to all participants (Working and Auditors) about 2 weeks before the event to gather information on everyone's desires/questions/issues they want help with. While the Working teams will have priority for what is focused on during time spent working dogs, Leah always makes time for/addresses the questions of all participants.

(Leah does an excellent job of getting to everyone's questions, she wants all participants to be heard, and I've often found that someone else's question is something I wondered about!)

<u>Cost:</u> As you can imagine, renting an entire campus building so we can train in a trial environment is not inexpensive, but it is worth it!

Working Team - \$325/day (\$250 + \$75 facility) Auditors - \$100/day Working one day/audit one day - \$375

People who attended Leah's seminar in 2023 will have priority for a working spot in this coaching workshop and I will be contacting you individually prior to open registration. I will have a waitlist after all working spots are filled. The waitlist for a working spot will be from people who have registered as auditors, and if a working spot comes open, I will have a drawing for it from the list of auditors. Registration opens February

24, 2024 and payment will be required to hold your spot. More info on that, and the link for waivers, will be sent when you register. I am expecting a lot of interest for this workshop - I will need to hold some kind of 'random draw' since there are only 6 working spots per day. I will do my best to keep everyone happy! Keep in mind auditing is very valuable in that you get to observe all the dogs and perhaps see behavior patterns you might otherwise miss.

I am really looking forward to this workshop - you all have interesting observations and questions for Leah, and I learn so much!
