Fox Rest Farm (2 Nose You Is 2 Loves You) is very pleased to welcome back Silke Wittig, CNWI, CPDT-KSA, CBCC-KA for a two day Nose Work seminar Monday and Tuesday, October 24-25, 2022 at Camp Whitley, 4305 W. Camp Whitley Rd., Columbia City, IN. She is the Certifying Official for the Elite/NW1 trial October 22-23, also at Camp Whitley. For those competing in the trial, I think this might also be a good opportunity to revisit some of the trial searches/ask questions about some of the searches that we don't often have time for immediately after a trial.

Silke is a professional dog trainer and behavior consultant who has been running HeRo Canine Consulting, LLC since 2006. She was introduced to K9 Nose Work in 2010 and became one of the first two CNWIs in Pennsylvania in 2011. Silke loves to work all aspects of this great dog sport while making sure both ends of the leash have fun in a safe environment! In addition to her own classes, Silke has hosted NACSW sanctioned ORTs, trials, workshops, and has been invited to teach at Georgia and Pennsylvania NW Camps. She is very involved with the NACSW organization - being a Trial Approval Coordinator as well as her Certifying Official duties for ORTs and Trials. Silke has a soft spot for shelter dogs and introduced Nose Work to several shelters who have now included it in their canine enrichment programs. Silke has an encouraging and enthusiastic style of teaching (and is a lot of fun!). I am so glad we could get her back for a workshop! Silke currently lives in Suwannee, GA with her husband, Axel, and their Pit Bull, Snap.

The workshop will start at 9:00 AM each day and run until 5:00 PM. Lunch will be included. We are able to accommodate a few RVs overnight for the workshop **ONLY (not for the trial). I have talked with the owner and she said there are some electrical outlets outside, but they are regular outlets so you will possibly need an adapter. We will have a lot of room for auditors. For those who are interested in 'camping' - some of the cabins are available for a small additional fee. Very rustic (unheated), but there are showers in the main bathroom. **Please contact me (Carolyn) if you are interested in using a cabin and/or bringing an RV.**

Fees and Cancellation Policy:

The cost is \$375/working team for the two day workshop with lunch included.

Auditors are \$30/day with lunch included.

RV and Cabin fee is \$30/night. Be aware you will need your own 'linens' or sleeping bag for the cabins and your own towels and shower supplies for the showers in the bathrooms.

CANCELLATION POLICY: Working teams will get a full refund minus \$30 if cancelled prior to October 1, 2022. After October 1, no refund unless I can fill the spot from the waitlist (then a full refund minus \$30).
