Schedule:

Monday - 9:00 AM - 5:30. We can't get in the building until 9:00, so no need to arrive much before 8:45 on Monday. Lunch is provided at noon and start back at 1:00. We can leave our 'stuff' in the building overnight.

Tuesday - 8:30 AM - 3:30. We will meet outside for discussion and move inside at 9:00. Lunch is provided at noon, and start back at 12:30. I will need to get Silke to the airport in time for her flight, so we will be on our way at 3:30 - 3:45. I will come back after I drop her off so there's no rush to be packed up at 3:30.
