She is the Certifying Official for the Elite/NW1 trial October 22-23, also at Camp Whitley. For those competing in the trial, I think this might also be a good opportunity to revisit some of the trial searches/ask questions about some of the searches that we don't often have time for immediately after a trial.

Silke is a professional dog trainer and behavior consultant who has been running HeRo Canine Consulting, LLC since 2006. She was introduced to K9 Nose Work in 2010 and became one of the first two CNWIs in Pennsylvania in 2011. Silke loves to work all aspects of this great dog sport while making sure both ends of the leash have fun in a safe environment! In addition to her own classes, Silke has hosted NACSW sanctioned ORTs, trials, workshops, and has been invited to teach at Georgia and Pennsylvania NW Camps. Silke has a soft spot for shelter dogs and introduced Nose Work to several shelters who have now included it in their canine enrichment programs.
